We rethink entire production processes and focus on the whole value chain. Our solutions improve energy efficiency and recyclability, reduce emissions and material consumption, replace harmful substances, increase quality, and accelerate and streamline manufacturing processes.

This sense of responsibility has been a core issue at Collano since the 1980s. We will continue to balance human and social needs, environmental requirements, and economic demands in all our future activities.

### Risk management and sustainability targets

Sustainability Circles are held periodically at Collano. In these interdisciplinary workshops, selected goals of the 2030 Agenda (UN SDG) are presented, and specific measures and projects are developed using creatively structured brainstorming sessions. Through these, Collano actively contributes to supporting the goals of the 2030 Agenda.

## Commitment to environmentally friendly production

Collano pays attention to the targeted use of resources to produce all services. Electricity is sourced from sustainable sources (Swiss hydropower). Electric charging stations are available in the parking lots for employees and visitors.

Collano holds quality, environmental, and sustainability certificates: ISO 9001 and ISO 14001, as well as Ecovadis.

# Promoting sustainable raw materials for Collano adhesives

As a chemical-technical company, many raw adhesive materials are subject to mandatory labeling. Collano constantly strives to increase the proportion of harmless or renewable raw materials. Recently, recycled or CO2-neutral raw materials have been used. Collano's "Chemical Compliance Group" continuously monitors compliance with international guidelines for using chemical raw materials, including ensuring REACH conformity and conformity with the Swiss Chemicals Act.

## Sustainable supply chain practices

Collano periodically surveys their suppliers on their CSR standards and activities, and their CSR performance is included in the supplier evaluation. Collano strives to design its supply sizes ecologically and economically by optimizing logistics and cooperating closely with suppliers and customers. Optimized delivery sizes help reduce the environmental impact, conserve resources, and cut costs.

#### **Customer focus and education**

Collano regularly conducts free adhesive and application training courses for customers and in vocational training and further education centers. These training courses are crucial in raising awareness among adhesive users about the economical use of adhesives, proper disposal, and the safe use of the latest sustainable technologies.

#### Paperless office and home office

Paperless working offers environmental benefits by saving resources such as wood and water, reducing waste and emissions, and improving energy efficiency, resulting in a lower environmental impact. In addition, a paperless office strategy is an essential prerequisite for efficient home office work. The latter reduces commuter traffic and offers benefits for employees' work-life balance.
